Tenure of SGA Sub-Committee members:

a. One year – 1st August to 31st July

ENGAGEMENT SUB-COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

- 1. Engage the golf community to introduce the game of golf
- Encourage mass participation of golf through events and activities organised or coorganised by SGA
- 3. Formulate ideas to engage industry stakeholders and relevant authorities to grow the game of golf
- 4. Develop strong partnerships with Club Captains and public golf facilities operators

MARCOM SUB-COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

- 1. Raise the identity of SGA and SGA's stakeholders
- 2. Formulates strategies on the branding and marketing of SGA
- 3. Explore traditional and modern MARCOM platforms to synergise SGA efforts to grow the game
- 4. Increase the profile of SGA programs and initiatives through social media/digital platforms
- 5. Provide guidance in communication materials and direction in alignment of content

RULES SUB-COMMITTEE

- Upholds the Rules of Golf and the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the R&A
- 2. Interprets and gives decisions on the Rules of Golf and to refer such matters to the R&A Rules Department, if necessary
- 3. Rules on matters concerning amateur status of golfers and to refer such matters to the R&A Rules Department, if necessary
- 4. Appoints SGA Referees for SGA tournaments including the appointment of Chief Referees and determining the number of referees for each tournament
- 5. Formulates and endorses the Hard Card and Local Rules for SGA tournaments in consultation with the Tournament Sub-Committee
- 6. Monitors the professionalism and conduct of SGA Referees
- 7. Conducts regular Rules of Golf seminars and workshops for SGA Referees with the objective of providing continued education and uplifting of the standard of SGA Referees
- 8. Recommends SGA Referees to represent Singapore at professional and/or amateur tournaments for endorsement by the SGA Executive Board
- 9. Reviews and recommends appropriate benefits for SGA Referees for approval by SGA Executive Board

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT SUB-COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

- 1. Attract young players to golf and impart them with the correct knowledge of the game
- 2. Engage the juniors in a fun setting to sustain their interest in golf
- 3. Provide the necessary platforms for young golfers to progress and retain their passion for the game
- 4. Discover and nurture talented junior golfers through Talent ID days or SGA/Club junior programs
- 5. Endorses selection of Junior Squad (JS) and Junior Development (JD) program players for overseas regional tournaments
- 6. Recommends selection and removal of players to the JS and JD program for endorsement by SGA Executive Board
- 7. Prepares annual training and overseas tournament budget of JS and JD for approval by SGA Executive Board
- 8. Carries out preliminary investigation on any disciplinary complaints made to SGA regarding JS and JD related issues

HANDICAP SUB-COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

- 1. Monitors compliance of the World Handicap System by all clubs
- 2. Carries out audit compliance checks on Ordinary or Associate clubs where necessary
- 3. Approves changes to clubs' request for any alterations to their members' handicap index
- 4. Conducts and reviews course ratings for golf courses of clubs
- 5. Monitors implementation and performance of the SGA Centralised Handicap System (CHS)

AUDIT & RISK SUB-COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

- 1. Checks on the adequacy of and, if necessary, implement internal control system and proper procedures for key processes
- 2. Ensures that all functions and activities of SGA comply with established policies and guideline procedures
- 3. Reviews with the external auditors their audit scope prior to the commencement of their audit
- 4. Reviews with the external auditors on any major findings, management letter and response
- 5. Recommends to the SGA Executive Board on the approval of the annual audited financial statements

FINANCE & INVESTMENT SUB-COMMITTEE

- 1. Overlook SGA Accounting and procurement procedures
- 2. Formulate and recommend update to SGA Investment Policy for the endorsement of SGA Executive Board and approval of the SGA Governing Council (if applicable)
- 3. Implementation of an adequately funded reserve program

4. Implementation of safeguards to protect association assets

TRAINING & DEVELOPMENT SUB COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

- 1. Promulgates selection policies for major games, eg, SEA Games and Asian Games, for the approval of the SGA Executive Board
- 2. Committee should consist of the Athlete Commission (AC) Representative
- 3. Recommend players for major games for endorsement by the SGA Executive Board
- 4. Recommends selection and removal of players to the National and Development Squads for endorsement by SGA Executive Board
- 5. Endorses training programs for National and Development Squads
- 6. Endorses selection of players for overseas regional tournaments
- 7. Monitors NS and DS members' performance and conduct through reports from National Coach and High-Performance Manager
- 8. Approves participation in selected overseas tournaments and any subsequent changes.
- 9. Set up and improve the strategy used in the SGA High Performance Program
- 10. Prepares annual training and overseas tournament budget for approval by SGA Executive Board
- 11. Monitor and evaluate performance of National Coach and High-Performance Manager.
- 12. Carries out preliminary investigation on any disciplinary complaints made to SGA regarding NS and DS members

TOURNAMENT SUB COMMITTEE

Terms of Reference

- 1. Prepares the annual SGA tournaments schedule complete with hosting venues for endorsement by SGA Executive Board
- 2. Recommends any changes to format of established SGA tournaments for endorsement by SGA Executive Board
- 3. Recommends any new tournaments for endorsement by SGA Executive Board
- 4. Prepares annual tournament budget for endorsement by SGA Executive Board
- 5. Recommends any sponsorship deals for endorsement by SGA Executive Board
- 6. Appoints organizing committees (if applicable) and tournament directors/chief referees (if applicable) to run SGA tournaments professionally
- 7. Co-ordinate with the Rules Sub-committee and approve Terms of Competition (TOC) for all SGA tournaments

SINGAPORE OPEN BOOTH SUB-COMMITTEE

- 1. Create and increase engagement with golf fans, invited guests and players at SGA Hospitality areas
- 2. Operate interactive games/activities at the booth to promote golf and branding of SGA
- 3. Support Singapore Open promoter and host venue on any other initiatives to enhance the overall experience of the National Open

GOVERNANCE & COMPLIANCE SUB-COMMITTEE

- 1. Review with the assistance of professional advisers, compliance of relevant legal & regulatory requirements of SGA
- 2. Review operating policies, standards & procedures implemented by SGA
- 3. Review such other voluntary codes or practices that have been adopted by other NSAs
- 4. Recommend best practices on how SGA can be more effectively governed and managed
- 5. Advise the Board on adherence to the Code of Governance for Charities and Institutions of a Public Character
