



## **SGA Junior Development Order of Merit 2023**

*Updated 28 August 2023*

### **Introduction**

SGA will maintain a Junior Development Order of Merit (JDOOM) for local SGA organised or sanctioned junior events. The JDOOM tracks players based on their performance from 1 Jan 2023 to 31 December 2023.

### **SGA JDOOM**

1. There are four divisions in the JDOOM:

<b>Division</b>	<b>Age (as of 1st Jan 2023)</b>
Boys 'A'	9-11 years old
Girls 'A'	9-11 years old
Boys 'B'	5-8 years old
Girls 'B'	5-8 years old

2. All juniors who are aged between 5-11 (as of 1 January 2023) are eligible to earn JDOOM points at the selected SGA organised or sanctioned events.
3. The JDOOM will be computed according to the total number of points that have been accumulated. The list will be updated at the beginning of each month. All tournaments up to the end of the preceding month will be captured.

## **Use of JDOOM**

4. The JDOOM will be used as the main selection tool for:
  - a. selection/requalification of juniors into the SGA Futures Squad.
    - i. The top 10 players in Boys & Girls 'A' Divisions will requalify for the SGA Future Squad in 2023
    - ii. The top 6 players in the Boys & Girls 'B' Divisions will requalify for the SGA Future Squad in 2023
    - iii. Any recommendations from High Performance Team and subject to the approval of Junior Development Sub-Committee
  - b. selection for SGA Junior Squad
    - i. The top 4 boys and top 4 girls in the Boys & Girls 'A' Division respectively will be invited to go for a trial assessment for the SGA Junior Squad selection in 2023.
    - ii. Any recommendations from High Performance Team and subject to the approval of Junior Development Sub-Committee

## **Points calculation**

5. Point values vary depending on the category of the event. The categories are based on field strength and the importance of the tournament. There are 2 categories for local events.
6. Tied scores receive position points added together and divided by the number of positions.
7. The SGA Junior Development committee reserves the right to amend the calendar and categories of the selected events.

8. The points distribution for each division is as follows:

\* Points for the SGA-Mandai Junior Golf Series will be distributed after every 8 legs. Each player must play at least 2 games within the 4 legs of each Division. The best combined score of the 2 games (highest stableford/lowest gross) will be used to allocate points.

Example of legs: 1st - 8th leg (1st cycle)  
9th - 16th leg (2nd cycle)  
17th - 24th leg (3rd cycle)  
25th - 32nd leg (4th cycle)  
33rd - 40th leg (5th cycle)
